#### **HAPPEN**. The MedZEB framework



The MedZEB approach aims at tackling unsolved and shared challenges of the retrofitting markets, such as **reconnecting** the fragmented value chain, rebuilding a **framework of trust** and increasing **convenience and appeal** of the deep renovation market. The MedZEB approach is defined through the following features:

- Tailored: specifically conceived for fostering deep retrofitting in the Med area;
- Holistic: integrating the most relevant fields for the retrofitting markets;
- Transparent: proposing novel tools for increasing quality and reliability of renovation markets;
- Adaptive: enhancing soft added-values of the retrofitting (such as flexibility and well-being).

### The MedZEB approach: why HOLISTIC?




HAPPEN seeks the integration of the following aspects into one OSS model:

- **Social field,** by developing engagement approaches addressing and joining all the actors of the retrofitting supply chain, from final users to market actors.
- **Technical field,** by developing cost-optimal technical packages of solutions (POS) taking into account also step-by-step renovation logics.
- **Financial field,** by developing an innovative financial solution fully integrated with the HAPPEN POS and the step-by-step approach.
- **Procedural field,** by developing the *HAPPEN programme*, that is a comprehensive implementation strategy of the MedZEB approach.



#### The MedZEB approach: toward optimal integrated solutions





The **Versatile Energy Loan** (VEL) is an innovative financial solution consisting of a cumulative mortgage issued at year zero and entailing multiple disbursement steps, corresponding to the POS. VEL is aimed at diluting and minimizing the renovation costs so to guarantee that the payback can be funded through the savings achieved. VEL is tuned with recent evolutions in the renovation market, such as the BPIE's Individual Building Renovation Passport (IBRP).

### The MedZEB approach: toward optimal integrated solutions



VEL pursues **maximum flexibility** as its main guiding principle, with special reference to:

- opting for an "all-in-one-step" solution, or for a step-by-step one;
- opting out of the retrofitting pathway at any step, following unpredictable family needs;
- accelerating the reimbursement by deciding at any time to co-fund some of the steps;
- updating the Renovation Roadmap on basis of supervening technical innovations.



The MedZEB Protocol is a guarantee scheme ensuring that the retrofitting process will be carried out properly along the whole value chain according to pre-set energetic, financial, environmental and well-being performances. This will allow subjects involved in the retrofitting to cooperate on basis of shared and agreed quality principles, procedures and targets, where responsibilities and control levels will be fully described.



The MedZEB Protocol includes the following documents:

- The **EPC** of the building as a starting point, plus a **dedicated audit**;
- The draft renovation project developed on basis of the HAPPEN POS;
- The Building Renovation Roadmap based on the step-by-step breakdown of the POS;
- The Business Plan based on the application of the VEL solution to the Roadmap;
- The **MedZEB Voluntary Certification Scheme** which will be issued at the end of the first renovation step and updated at each further step after carrying out proper monitoring.


