



The Renovation Wave

- Major initiative by the European Commission in the framework of the European Green Deal
- Strategic communication –
 with an action plan –
 published on 14 October
 2020
- Concerted action at all levels, from local to regional, national and European

The Renovation Wave – digital buildings

- "Tackling the twin challenges of the green and digital transitions together. Smart buildings can enable efficient production and use of renewables at house, district or city level. Combined with smart energy distribution systems, they will enable highly efficient and zero-emission buildings."
- "Promoting comprehensive and integrated renovation interventions for smart buildings, integration of renewable energy and enabling to measure actual energy consumption. The new Smart Readiness Indicator promotes digitally friendly renovations (...)"

The Smart Readiness Indicator

- Voluntary scheme for Member States
- Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (2010/31/EU)
- Two legal acts: delegated act (methodology) and implementing act (implementation modalities)
- Adopted by the Commission jointly with the RW Communication
- National test phases from 2021



LIFE sub-programme on Clean Energy Transition

Continuation of market uptake actions building upon predecessor programmes Intelligent Energy Europe (2003-2013) and Coordination and Support Actions under Horizon 2020 Energy Efficiency (2014-2020).




- Key objective: creating market & regulatory enabling conditions for the clean energy transition
- Supports energy efficiency and renewable energy projects



Horizon Europe - Built4People partnership

3 pillars: excellent science, global challenges and industrial competitiveness, and innovative Europe.

Cluster 5 of pillar II: cluster on climate, energy and mobility.



Built4People' (BP4) R&I partnership: to foster R&I on people-centric sustainable built environment.
