





SUSTAINABLE PLACES 2019 in collaboration with Green Building Cuncil Italia proposes a workshop dedicated to the launch of the BUILD UPON2 Italian Cluster

BUILD UPON2 project will work with Cities to support the EU's goal of decarbonising it's building stock by 2050, by strengthening the effectiveness and implementation of the long-term building renovation strategies required under the EPBD.

8 Green Building Councils, 8 Pilot Covenant of Mayors signatories cities, 24 Follower Cities, Climate Alliance, BPIE, national governments and key national stakeholders will collaborate in BUILD UPON2 project to develop a Multilevel Impact Network of Indicators to measure the impact of local initiatives for building renovation and enhance the coordination among national regional and local objectives of decarbonization of the built environment.

The workshop launches the Italian Cluster of BUILD UPON2 project that aims at involving cities and stakeholders into project actions and newtorking events.

Results of the first BUILD UPON project and the objectives of the BUILD UPON2 project are introduced. 3 initiatives undertaken by cities are presented to understand their impact across multiple benefits areas for the renovation strategies at local, regional, national and EU level (e.g. on emissions reductions, increased jobs, decreased public health costs etc.).
