Designed by the renowned Renzo Piano Building Workshop and completed in 2019, **the venue sets the example in sustainability and well-being.** The building is LEED Certified (Gold), has an SRI assessment score over 54%, uses eco-friendly materials and operates using advanced building operations systems. The **Call for Proposals will launch on 30 April** and extend through the end of June. The venue will allow us to design the event leveraging:

- A 300 person amphitheater
- Four fully instrumented meeting rooms
