




SP2025: Get your Ticket, Make a Difference

When registering, you will have the option to pay by credit card using Stripe or via invoice and bank transfer.



For those paying by credit card, your ticket will be issued at checkout.

For those paying by invoice / bank transfer, selecting this option will put you in touch with our administrative staff at R2M who will provide the information necessary for payment via invoice.

Once payment is received, your ticket will be issued through the Humantix platform.

Ticket prices are inclusive of platform fees. These do not impact ticket price. **Tickets are not inclusive of VAT which in Italy is 22%**. Italy requires the collection of VAT for conference registrations regardless of country of origin. VAT refund applications are handled through each registrant country's tax authority's electronic portal under Directive 2008/9/EC.

Reminder: the Early Bird registration ends 31 July.
