Call for Proposals



** Arriving in Milan - What you need to know

If you have questions about which airport to select, there are three good options - all with convenient connections to Milan in under an hour:

Linate (LIN): The closest option, now directly connected to the Milan metro system via the new M4 line. You can reach most parts of the city in just 15–30 minutes.

Malpensa (MXP): Well connected via the Malpensa Express train, with two arrival stations — Milano Centrale and Milano Cadorna — both linked to the metro. Travel time: about 30 minutes.

Bergamo (BGY): Served by frequent shuttle buses departing just outside the terminal. They reach Milano Centrale in around 1 hour.

Wherever you land, Milan is within easy reach — and we can't wait to see you there!

Accomodation in Milan

Milan offers a wide range of hotels and apartments. Do book before last minute, as pricing may be a consideration.

Five locations within walking distance or easily connected to the venue via metro (M1) are shown in the below table.

The **SP organization team** is in discussion with these venues, who will consider our request for discounted event pricing starting **1 September**.

Our recommendation:

If you are planning ahead, book your accommodation now for the best availability. For those booking in early September, some discounts may still be available — though likely in line with standard booking website rates.

- 1. Hotel Lido Via R. Galli 8, 20148 Milano, just 800 meters walking distance from the venue.
- 2. **B&B Hotel Milano Portello** Via Guglielmo Silva 12, 20149 Milano, **only 500 meters away**. Walking distance.
- 3. **Hotel Campion** Viale Berengario 3, 20149 Milano, around 700 meters from the venue. Walking distance.
- 4. Hotel des Estrangers Via Sirte 9, 20146 Milano, about 3.2 km away, reachable by Bus line 90.
- 5. **Hotel Wagner** Via M. Buonarroti 13, Fiera Milano City, 20149 Milano, roughly **1.4 km** from the venue, easily accessible via **Metro Line M1.**

General Event Agenda

? Thematic Track: Smart Readiness Indicator - Tools, Results and Implementation



Wednesday, 9 October, 0900-1300, Main Auditorium

Opened by the European Commission and chaired by Working Group 3 of the SRI Platform – bringing together stakeholders from the building sector, research, and industry – this thematic track is **co-organized by LIFE-CET SMARTREADY SRI** projects nearing completion. The Smart Readiness Indicator will take center stage at Sustainable Places.

This 4-hour thematic track will showcase results from around **10 R&D projects** focused on the SRI and will welcome over 100 building professionals for discussion and dialogue on SRI uptake, EPBD implementation, and practical insights from the field. The SRI assessment result of MonteRosa 91 will be shared along with other case studies to stimulate round table discussions. We look forward to this engaging and insightful track!
