Museum of Ancient Art – approx. 45 minutes Museum of the Pietà – approx. 20 minutes Panoramic Battlements – approx. 20 minutes


The museum is just 15 minutes away on the red metro line (from Lotto to Cadorna), making it very easy to reach!
